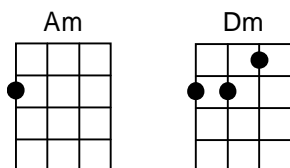


Love Potion No. 9

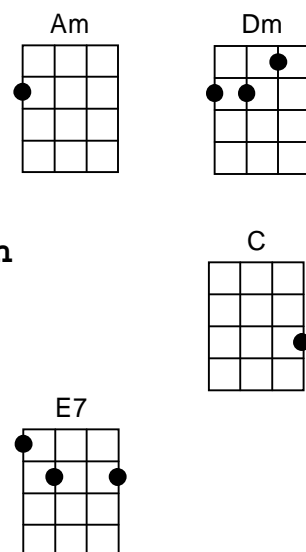
Jerry Leiber and Mike Stoller, 1959

Love Potion Number Nine

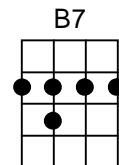


Verse 2
